





In the afternoon we will move to the heart of the historic center with a visit to the main Reinassance squares and fountains or Rome, Piazza di Spagna, with its Fontana della Barcaccia, Piazza di Trevi, with the most famous Fountain, and Piazza Colonna. After a short stop, we will visit Piazza della Rotonda, with its splendid Reinassance fountain and the Pantheon, built by Emperor Hadrian in the second century A.D, still one of the most misteriuos monument in the world. We will end the tour in the famous Piazza Navona with the magnificent Fountain of the Four Rivers, sculptured by Bernini. End of the tour and return to the hotel individually, overnight stay.

#### Day 3

#### **PAPAL BASILICAS**

Breakfast at the hotel, meet with the guide for the four Papal Basilicas tour and their masterpieces. The first Basilica will be the Basilica of St. Peter, built between 1506 and 1626, followed by a visit to St. John in Lateran, the ancient seat of the papacy, then St. Paul outside the walls and St. Mary Major which pre- serves paleo Christian mosaics dating back to the 5th century. Day 4

#### **FRASCATI**

Breakfast, check-out and transfer to Frascati. Meet with the guide for a historical center of the city guided-tour. We will stroll through the streets of one of the most renowned municipalities of the Roman Castles, famous for the various Tuscolan villas, where, once, illustrious patrician families lived. The town is also known for the cathedral of St. Peter in neo-Renaissance baroque style and the church of Jesus "Gesù "built in the eighteenth century by the genius of Carlo Fontana. Roman Castles are famous for their good wine and delicious food. Visited the city center, we will move to a local winery surrounded by nature, vineyards and olive groves. In this area vines have been cultivated since Roman times, it is possible to visit ancient caves where wine has been aged for millennia. You will know more about the techniques of working the vine and the winemaking processes. Not only talks, It's time to taste the famous Frascati wine! Three locally produced wines, including the famous white wine Frascati Superiore DOCG. The better way to end a perfect morning, it's a delicious lunch, an appetizer and a first course of the Roman tradition. At the end of the visit, transfer to the 4\* hotel. Afternoon at leisure, overnight stay.

Day 5

#### **TWO-NIGHT EXTENSION**

Breakfast at the hotel. Transfer to Castel Gandolfo, a delightful town overlooking Lake Albano, one of the most beautiful villages in Italy, known for the presence of the Papal Palace, the pope's summer residence. Guided tour of the city center. We will visit the ancient city center with the Papal Palace, the Pontifical Villas, and the beautiful gardens. A journey that recounts the history of the papacy from the seventeenth century to the Lateran Pacts, from the stay of John Paul II and Benedict XVI to the transformation into a museum by Pope Francis. At the end of the tour, we will continue the guided tour, to Ariccia. Here we can admire the buildings that overlook Piazza di Corte designed by Gian Lorenzo Bernini together with the Collegiate Church of Santa Maria Assunta, Palazzo Chigi (from the outside) and the famous Ariccia bridge. The majesty of the place and the natural beauty that surrounds it have made it a destination of the Grand Tour. Return to Frascati, afternoon at leisure.
