

Classical and Renaissance beauty

Day 1

- Arrival in Rome, accommodation in a 4* hotel in the city center. Afternoon at disposal. Dinner and overnight stay.

Day 2

- Breakfast at the hotel. Morning tour: **Rome archeological walking tour**



*Meet with the guide for the visit of the largest archaeological area in the world. We will begin our tour from the Flavian Amphitheater, better known as **the Colosseum**, it is one of the most visited monuments ever, an icon of the Capitoline city. We continue to the **Imperial Forums**, a series of monuments and archaeological remains that were once the stage of political life. We will end the morning with the visit of the Capital hill (Campidoglio), with its square.*

- Time for lunch (not included). Afternoon tour: **walking tour of the historical center of Rome**



We will move to the heart of the historic center with a visit to Piazza di Spagna and the Trevi Fountain, Piazza Colonna and the palaces of Italian political power. After a short stop, visit to Piazza della Rotonda where you can see the Pantheon built by Emperor Hadrian in the second century A.D. and Piazza Navona with the magnificent Fountain of the Four Rivers by Bernini.

- Dinner and overnight stay

Day 3

- Breakfast at the hotel. Morning tour: **visit of St. Peter's square and the Vatican Museums**



*St. Peter's square is located in front of **St. Peter's Basilica** in the Vatican City, both the square and the basilica are named after Saint Peter. We will visit the square and then proceed to the **Vatican Museums**, where various works are collected, from ancient to contemporary times. The tour ends in the **Sistine Chapel** where it is possible to admire the famous frescoes of the representation of the Last Judgment.*

- Time for lunch (not included). Afternoon tour: **private transfer and visit of Frascati, wine tasting and cooking class**



*We will stroll through the streets of Frascati, one of the most renowned municipalities of the **Roman Castles**, famous for the various Tuscolan villas once home to illustrious patrician families.*

*How to end a perfect trip at the Roman Castles? Pasta **cooking class**, with **wine tasting** is a must-do if you are near Rome! We will attend the wine tour and pasta making class, a perfect cultural experience, in a perfect location, a local winery surrounded by nature, vineyards and olive groves.*

- Return to Rome and overnight at the hotel

Day 4

- Breakfast at the hotel and check-out. Private transfer from Rome to Florence, accommodation in a 4* hotel in the city center. Morning tour: **visit of the city center**



*Morning dedicated to the discovery of Florence and its treasures. With the guide we will walk through the streets of the historic center where you can admire famous monuments, buildings and statues of world renowned artists, such as Michelangelo's David, Palazzo degli Uffizi and **Palazzo Vecchio**. Do not miss the stop at **Ponte Vecchio**, symbol of the city of Florence and Tuscany in general, and the Fontana del Porcellino where traditionally you touch your nose in the hope of receiving good luck in return.*

- Time for lunch (not included). Afternoon tour: **optional visit of Uffizi Gallery (not included, on request)**



*The guided Uffizi tour leads you through the most important masterpieces so you will be able to understand their beauty, importance, meaning and style. Among them, **The Birth of Venus**, perhaps the Uffizi's most famous work. The Museum itself is a masterpiece, the East, South and West corridors on the top floor of the **Uffizi Galleries** are an iconic feature of the Gallery, and indeed the term "Galleria" universally used to describe a collection of paintings originated from this very place.*

- Dinner and overnight stay

Day 5

- Breakfast at the hotel and private transfer to **Pisa**.

We will begin the walking tour from **Piazza dei Miracoli**, which shows many Unesco heritage site buildings: the Cathedral, the Baptistery, the Monumental Cemetery, and its famous Leaning Tower. We will reach Piazza dei Cavalieri, from there we will see the Palazzo della Carovana, then we will go to discover the Piazza Delle Vettovaglie ... Here we will find the **Borgo Stretto**, composed shopping streets very popular with both tourists and locals. Along the Arno, we will admire fabulous and many other monuments that our guide will not fail to present.

- Lunch, not included. Afternoon tour: **optional visit of Lucca (not included, on request)**



Most of the attractions in Lucca today show its ancient history. We will walk around this medieval city with its **Roman amphitheater**, that can be seen in the shape of the Piazza dell'Anfiteatro to the archeological remains under the 12th century church of Saints Giovanni and Reparata (the first city cathedral, to the various towers and villas from the 12th to 16th centuries. The top of the medieval walls has become a **pedestrian promenade**

- Dinner and overnight stay at the hotel

Day 6

- Breakfast at the hotel, check out and private transfer to **Siena** and guided tour



We will begin our visit from **Piazza del Campo** with the Torre del Mangia and the façade of the Palazzo Pubblico. In this square the famous Palio di Siena is organized, a horse race organized by the districts of the city. We will continue towards Palazzo Tolomei, once home to illustrious personalities, arriving to **the Duomo of Siena**. Inside this temple we will find a sublime collection of masterpieces of art, among which the Maestà by Duccio di Buoninsegna and the statue of St. Paul, sculpted by a very young Michelangelo.

- Transfer to **Montalcino** for lunch



Within the Val d'Orcia is a strip of land following the Orcia river between the DOCG zones of Brunello di Montalcino and Vino Nobile di Montepulciano. The Val d'Orcia is a region surrounded by nature, unmistakable explosion of flavors, scents, and aromas. We will have a typical Tuscany lunch, accompanied by excellent Tuscany wines, such as Brunello di Montalcino.

- Afternoon, transfer to Rome, accommodation in a 4*hotel in the city center. Dinner and overnight stay
