

Pilgrimage from Vienna to Warsaw

Day 1

- Arrival in Vienna, transfer from the airport to the hotel. Accommodation in a 4* hotel in the city center
- Time at disposal, dinner and overnight stay

Day 2

Breakfast at the hotel. Morning tour: visit of Vienna city center and the Dome



First part panoramic tour by coach along the Ringstrasse, admiring the wonderful historical buildings of the city: the **State Opera**, the Museum of Fine Arts, the Museum of Natural History and the cultural quarter with the museum quarter. At the end of the bus tour, we will vist the city center of Vienna, the **St. Stephen's Cathedral**, the symbol of Vienna and one of the most important Gothic structures in Austria. We will stroll the beautiful pedestrian streets of Graben and Kohlmarkt to end with the Augustinian church.

• Time for lunch (not included). Afternoon tour: transfer to Schoenbrunn and visit of the castle



Schönbrunn Palace is a UNESCO WORLD HERITAGE SITE and Austria's most visited tourist attraction. For centuries the palace served as the summer home of the Habsburgs, and to this day reflects the interests and tastes of the Habsburg monarchs. Schönbrunn is one of Europe's most impressive Baroque palace complexes and Austria's most significant cultural monument. At the end of the walking tour, we will reach the wonderful gardens and move to the Belvedere.

• Return to Vienna. Dinner and overnight stay

Day 3

 Breakfast at the hotel and check-out, private transfer to Prague. Accommodation in a 4* hotel in the city center. Time at disposal. Dinner and overnight stay

Day 4

• Breakfast at the hotel and transfer to the city center. Morning tour: visit of the city center.





We will visit the **Prague Castle** and have a tour of the castle and at the **St. Vitus Cathedral**, located within Prague Castle and holds the relics of the first Czech saint: **Saint Wenceslas**. From here, we will have a walk in the Mala Strana district which leads to the **Church of Our Lady Victorious (Thursday and Sunday holy mass in English)**, one of the most well-known devotions for Catholics throughout the world is for many people is to the **Infant Jesus of Prague**. We will cross the Charles Bridge that connects Lesser Town (Malá Strana) and the Old Town. Here will admire the Old Square and its

Astronomical Clock and and the Cathedral of Tyn.

• Time for lunch (not included). Afternoon tour: walking tour through the historical paths of Prague



To immerge yourself in this rich history, the best starting point is Wenceslas Square, from here we will stroll along Na Prikope Street until the Powder Tower, the Municipal House and the Estates Theatre. We will walk around the Jewish Quarter (Josefov), the former Ghetto and finally, we will take a boat cruise, to admire this beautiful city and its monuments from the river

Day 5

Breakfast at the hotel and check-out. Transfer from Prague to Krakow. Accommodation in a 4* hotel
in the city center. Time at disposal. Dinner and overnight stay

Day 6

Breakfast at the hotel. Morning tour: visit of the historical center (English Holy Mass during the day)



We will visit the historical center and the great Rynek Square, take a look to the Fabric Market and to the inside of **St. Mary's Basilica**. From here we will take a walk on Kanonicza Street to see the Pope's window, entering to the **Franciscan Church**. The walking tour will continue to the **Wawel Hill**, with a visit to the Royal Castle and the St. Stanislaus and St. Wenceslaus Cathedral.

Time for lunch (not included). Afternoon tour: visit of the Jewish quarter and St. Faustina Sanctuary

In the afternoon, our guide will lead us to the Jewish Quarter of Kazimierz and to the St. Faustina Sanctuary in Lagiewniki. Lagiewniki is a southern district of Krakow and is known across the world for its huge new Sanctuary of Divine Mercy. Originally, the Sanctuary was in the nearby convent of the Sisters of Our Lady of Mercy, where St Faustina Kowalska lived and died.

Dinner and overnight stay at the hotel

Day 7



Breakfast at the hotel. Morning tour: excursion to Wadowice



We will dedicate this morning to the discover of Wadowice, hometown of St. John Paul II. He was baptised in the local Church of the Presentation of Our Lady. The church is just a few dozen metres from Karol Wojtyła's family home, which now houses the John Paul II Family Home Museum.


• Time for lunch (not included). Afternoon tour: visit of Auschwitz Concentration Camp

We will visit the Auschwitz-Birkenau concentration camp. A historical journey inside the concentration camp, with the exploration of the blocks of imprisonment, the gas chambers and the crematory ovens.

Return to Krakow, dinner and overnight stay

Day 8

Breakfast at the hotel and check-out. Morning tour: excursion to Czestochowa



We will enjoy a guided tour of the Sanctuary, the Pauline Monastery, and the Sacred Icon of the Black Madonna. After the guided tour, attend the Holy Mass and time for individual prayer.

Transfer to Warsaw and accommodation in a 4* hotel in the city center. Afternoon at disposal.
 Dinner and overnight stay

Day 9

• Breakfast at the hotel. Morning tour: guided tour of the historical center



Among the wonders of this city we will visit the Market Square of Old city, the New city, the Barbican, **the Cathedral of San Giovanni** and the **Royal Castle** to continue along the Royal section to the Church of the Holy Cross, where there is the urn with the heart of Frederic Chopin.



• Time for lunch (not included). Afternoon tour: visit of Niepokalanow. (Transfer included)



Niepokalanów monastery is a Roman Catholic religious community founded in 1927 by Friar Minor Conventual Friar Maximilian Kolbe,

the priest who volunteered to die in place of a stranger in the German death camp of Auschwitz, located in German-occupied Poland during World War II.

Return to Warsaw, dinner and overnight stay

Day 10

• Breakfast at the hotel and check-out. Transfer to the airport for the return flight
