

# Colorful Portugal: weekend in Lisbon

---

## Day 1

- Arrival in Lisbon, accommodation in a 4\* hotel in the city center
- Afternoon tour: **walking tour of Rossio, Baixa, Bairro Alto e Alfama**



*Meet with the guide. With a walk from our hotel, through Av. Da Liberdade we will reach the Bairro Alto, a tangle of alleys and small shops. In this neighborhood is the Igreja Sao Roque, whose interiors are in gold marble and Florentine azulejos. Crossing Placa Rossio, we will reach Rua Augusta, where we will go up to the Santa Justa Lift from which you can enjoy a splendid view of Lisbon (ticket to be taken on site). The Santa Justa elevator will take us to Largo do Carmo. Here we will visit the Convento do Carmo (entrance to be taken on site). Our walking tour will end in the Alfama district, the oldest district in Lisbon, known for its fado houses and popular festivals dedicated to the patron saints, to Sant'Antonio.*

- Dinner: **Fado show dinner (not included, on request)**
- Overnight stay.

## Day 2

- Breakfast at the hotel, private transfer to Sintra.
- Morning tour: **visit of Sintra and its Palacio da Pena**



*We will visit the famous **Palacio Nacional de Sintra** (entrance ticket included), a Unesco World Heritage Site. It is a white palace located in the heart of Sintra and known for being the most inhabited royal residence.*

- Time for lunch (not included).
- Afternoon: private transfer to **Cabo da Roca and Cascais**

We will proceed to **Cabo de Roca**, the westernmost point of the European continent with a breathtaking view of the ocean. Our tour will end in the beautiful little town of **Cascais**, one of the main tourist destinations in Portugal.

- Private transfer to the hotel in Lisbon. Dinner and overnight stay

## Day 3

- Breakfast at the hotel and check-out.
- Morning tour: **visit of the historic Belem district, entry into the Jeronimos Monastery**



*We will visit the Belém district, with its sweeping views over the river and the monuments that make Lisbon famous. One of the most famous is certainly the **Belém Tower** (from the outside), a Manueline-style building, a symbol of the era of great geographical discoveries. Strolling along the riverside we will arrive at the **Padrao dos Descobrimentos**, a limestone colossus that depicts various Portuguese characters, including the explorer Vasco De Gama. We will visit the **Mosteiro dos Jeronimos** (admission included), a Manueline Gothic style monastery, founded in 1501 to celebrate the discovery of the route to the Indies. Today it is a Unesco World Heritage Site. We will visit the church, the cloister, one of the most beautiful in the world, the chapter house and the southern portal.*

- Time for lunch (not included).
- Optional tour: **Lisbon boat tour (not included, on request)**
- Transfer to the airport 2 hours before your flight
