



PRAGUE AND BOHEMIA

Discover Prague and the famous region of Bohemia

Immerse yourself into the magic region of the Bohemia. Explore Prague and its famous attractions and most important monuments; enjoy a daytrip to Karlovy Vary and immerse yourself into the Bohemian region.

1st Day

Prague

Arrival in Prague and transfer to a 4* hotel located in the city center. Afternoon free for individual visit. Overnight stay.

2nd Day

Prague

Breakfast at the hotel. Meeting with the guide. Transfer to **Prague Castle** (one-way transfer)

Your walking tour will start at the **Prague Castle** (ticket to be purchased on the spot), we will visit the Courtyard of Honour and the **Saint Vitus Cathedral**, and houses the relics of the first Czech saint: **Wenceslas**. We will have the opportunity to visit the interior of the Castle and the famous **Golden Lane**, a small street characterized by the presence of low colorful houses (entrance to Golden Lane to buy on the spot ca. 10 € per person).

Free time for lunch. After lunch you will continue the guided tour with your guide.

You will cross the **Charles Bridge** connecting the Lesser Town (Lesser Town) and the Old Town. You will visit (from the outside) the symbols of the city of Prague: the Old Square, the **Powder Tower** and the **Astronomical Clock**, known by the Czech name of **Staromestsky Orloj**, is a scientific monument dating back to the medieval period.

With a walk in the district **Nove Mesto** (New Town), we will reach Wenceslas Square, symbol of the Prague Springs and the city itself.



Individual return to the hotel and overnight stay.

3rd Day

Prague

Breakfast at the hotel and transfer to **Karlovy Vary**. Meeting with the guide and walking tour.

Guided tour of the city, along the characteristic avenues with baroque and **Art Nouveau** buildings that overlooking the long pedestrian street.

Free time for lunch. In the afternoon visit to the **Moser Museum of glass**, where the precious Bohemian crystals famous throughout the world are created the world.

Enjoy some free time to buy some souvenirs. Return to Prague and overnight stay.

4th Day

Ceski Krumlov

Breakfast at the hotel and check-out. Meeting with the driver and transfer to Cesky Krumlov.

On the way you will stop to **Hluboka Castle** for a guided tour (ticket included).

Hluboka Castle is a wonderful example of Gothic architecture, you will visit the winter garden and the riding hall of **South Bohemia**.



Transfer to **Cesky Krumlov**. Free time for lunch, accommodation in 4* hotel in the city center.

Guided tour of the medieval city

Cesky Krumlov is a true historical jewel, with its characteristic streets, the ancient buildings wisely renovated and bridges over the **Vltava**. The guide will tell you the history of this small village and its peculiarity.

Return to the hotel and overnight stay.

5th Day

Prague

Breakfast at the hotel, check-out and meeting with the guide in the reception.

Before return to Prague, you will **visit the Castle of Cesky Krumlov**.

Free time for lunch. Meeting with the driver and transfer to Prague. Accommodation in 4* hotel in the city center and overnight stay.



6th Day

Prague

Breakfast at the hotel, check-out and transfer to the airport 3 hours before your flight.

Transfer from the airport to the hotel and VV; Transfer from hotel to Prague Castle (one-way transfer); Transfer from hotel in Prague to Karlovy Vary and VV; Transfer from hotel in Prague to Hluboka Castle; from Hluboka Castle to hotel in Cesky Krumlov; transfer from Cesky Krumlov to Prague hotel. Accommodation in 4* hotel in the city center with breakfast, Prague (4 nights), Cesky Krumlov (1 night). Guided tour: Prague (4 hours); Karlovy Vary and Moser Museum of glass (4 hours); Hluboka Castle (2 hours); Cesky Krumlov (3 hours); Cesky Krumlov Castle (3 hours). Entrance tickets: Moser Museum of glass; Hluboka Castle; Cesky Krumlov Castle.
